PACKAGES:

In order to participate in this event, **ALL** Coaches and Athletes are required to purchase the minimum Travel Package through GET Travel by calling [1-888-877-4445](tel:1-888-877-4445) or emailing info@GETTravel.com. Specially priced travel Packages are also available for other members of your traveling party including parents, chaperones, and spectators. Teams who stay overnight for the tournament are required to purchase the tournament travel package. Local teams who do not stay over night are required to purchase the local package (Disneyland theme park ticket only).

Participant check-in is required for this event. Unless another location is specified, all event registrations

LOCATION:

place *La Bonita Park in La Habra, California prior to the first game scheduled for each respective team.* Please allow 30 minutes to register before your first game.

TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation is available to/from the softball venue **ONLY** for individuals purchasing the softball tournament travel package, IF your team stays overnight for the tournament.

DEADLINE:**

The following **MUST** be submitted by **Friday, September 19th, 2008.**

1. All Disney's Sports Waiver Forms (located at www.disneylandsports.com), sent to GET Travel Sports
2. Official ASA Roster & National Championship Entry Form (find local ASA commissioner at www.softball.org). Teams in SoCal ASA will be provided the National Championship Entry Form at registration.

All Sports Waiver Forms must be received by **Friday, September 19th, 2008**. It is suggested that the coach carry proof of age for each participant (birth certificate, driver's license, passport etc) in case any questions arise. Each coach will be required to complete a "Contact Form" at Registration. This form will enable us to contact the coach in the case of inclement weather and revisions to the game schedules. It is recommended that each coach list a least 2-3 cell/hotel phone numbers.

SANCTIONING:

The Amateur Softball Association of America (ASA) sanctions this tournament. In order to participate, your team is required to be a member of the ASA. You will need to register your team prior to your arrival by visiting your local ASA website, you can find your local web site at www.softball.org.

Player Identification: This event is an ASA Hall of Fame Qualifier Invitational Tournament, and each player is required to have either a Player Identification Card or a copy of their birth certificate. Please note for those players who do not have a Player Identification Card, although the birth certificates may not be

collected, all players without Player Identification Cards will need them should any conflicts or protests occur.

ROSTERS: **ASA Roster:** In order to participate in this tournament, an Official ASA Roster must be submitted prior to the start of the tournament. Contact your local ASA commissioner at www.softball.org to obtain a roster.

SCHEDULES: **All teams should be prepared to begin play after 5:00 PM on Friday, October 10, 2008.** (Please see "cancellation policy" if your team is unable to meet this time frame.) You will receive your First Game Start Time by E-Mail NO LATER THAN Friday, October 3, 2008

STARTING TIME: Line-up cards will be handed out at check in. Each game card should be given to the scorekeeper 15 minutes prior to the game. Game balls are exchanged for line-ups. Line-ups must include each athlete's first and last name, number and position.

AGE DIVISIONS: This is a sanctioned ASA Girls Fastpitch Tournament.

Age 18 and Under Division
Age 16 and Under Division
Age 14 and Under Division
Age 12 and Under Division

AGE DETERMINATION: The player's playing age eligibility is determined by the **playing age for 2009.**

RULES: ASA rules will apply.

Protests: All protests will be determined by the UIC and Tournament Director. Umpire judgment calls **CANNOT** be protested. Unsuccessful forfeit funds will be donated to a charity to be selected by the event manager.

Game Times: All teams should be ready to play at least one half hour prior to the schedule start time. In some instances, some games may be started earlier should field space become available and games run ahead of time.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Double Elimination per ASA rules.

UNIFORMS: Uniforms must meet ASA Rules as outlined in the ASA rule book.

WEATHER: In the event of inclement weather, the following rain protocol will be observed:

- In the case of lightning or severe rain, all competition will be halted and all guests will be asked to report to a designated lightning shelter. The competition will resume if the weather clears, or be postponed to the following day (in the case of severe weather).
- In the case of light rain, competition will continue until safety becomes an issue, at which time competition will be halted and the above protocol will be observed.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing and must be received prior to the tournament draw. Teams that cancel before the tournament draw is drafted will have the opportunity to "roll-over" their entry fee into a future tournament, within a year, at *Disneyland*. Teams who cancel after the tournament draw will roll-over privileges. Please note, there are no refunds due to inclement weather, despite the number of games played.
